

# SRI VENKATESWARA UNIVERSITY: TIRUPATI ORIENTAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE



#### **ABOUT THE INSTITUTE:**

The Oriental Research Institute was established in July 1939 by Tirumala Tirupati Desasthanms, Tirupati. Prof. S.K. Belvalkar of Benaras Hindu University, Pune and prepared a "A SCHEME FOR AN ORIENTAL RESEARCH INSTITUTE AT TIRUPATI" and submitted the report on 11<sup>th</sup> September 1937 on request of the then Hon'ble Minister of Religious Endowments, Madras, Dr. Rajan and the then Commissioner Sri A. Ranganatha Mudaliyar of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams. The TTD Committee has sanctioned Sri Venkateswara Oriental Institute at Tirupati on April, 1938. Thus, S.V. Oriental Institute came into existence only in July, 1939.

Sri Venkateswara University was formed on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 1954. In 1956 S V Oriental Institute renamed as "**Sri Venkateswara University Oriental Research Institute**" and merged into S.V. University, Tirupati with the view to promote its activities in a broader perspective with well qualified research staff. The Institute was involved in multi disciplined based, multi lingual research in S.V. University. Keeping in view of extensive and wide arrange in research activities.

The Institute has been providing M.Phil. and Ph.D. courses in Telugu, Sanskrit, Indian Culture, Philosophy subjects. At present more than 15 students doing their Ph.Ds in ORI. The Institute staff brought out so many critical editions and reprints last eight decades. S.V.Oriental Journal started in TTD named with "Annuals of Sri Venkateswara". Now the Journal renamed "S.V.U.ORI Journal" and brings out 62 volumes.

The Institute acted as research consultancy is given regularly regarding manuscriptology and Paleography to various research scholars of different universities and foreign scholars who visited to institute. The ORI also provide reference and reprographic service Xerox copies and scanned images and CDs for extended.

The Institute execution a vital role as preventive preservation and conservation centre of Ancient Indian Culture and Literature. So many

Scholars visited throughout world to study culture depicted in manuscripts of ORI. The Institute having valuable manuscripts belongs to Samkeerthans of Annamayya family writers, Veerabrahmam Kalaznanam, Vemana verses and so many Ayurvedic texts.

The Institute conducted awareness campaigns, exhibitions and Workshops on Manuscriptology and Paeleography.

#### **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

The following are the fields of its activities: Collection and Preservation Manuscripts, Editing and Publication of Rare Manuscripts, Publication of Journals, Preparation Descriptive Catalogues, Conducting of Exhibition and Awareness Campaigns, Maintenance of the Manuscripts and Printed books Library, promote Inter and Multidisciplinary Research leading to M.Phil& Ph.D degrees and holding National and International Conferences, Seminars and Workshops. Extending Research and Referral Services on Indology to the scholars of various Universities from all over India and abroad.

#### **ABOUT ORI MANUSCRIPT LIBRARY**

The library of the institute contains Manuscripts Section and Printed Books Library. It has about 14,960 old and rare palm leaf and paper Manuscripts. The printed section library contains about 26,000 old and rare books published from 1804 and more than 16,000 new printed books besides 5,000 volumes of back volume journals.
